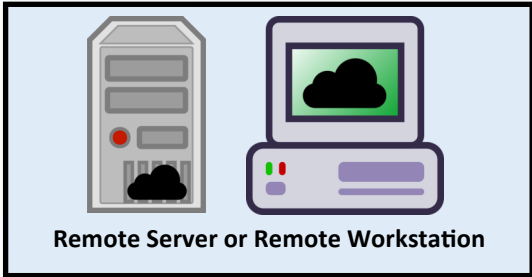


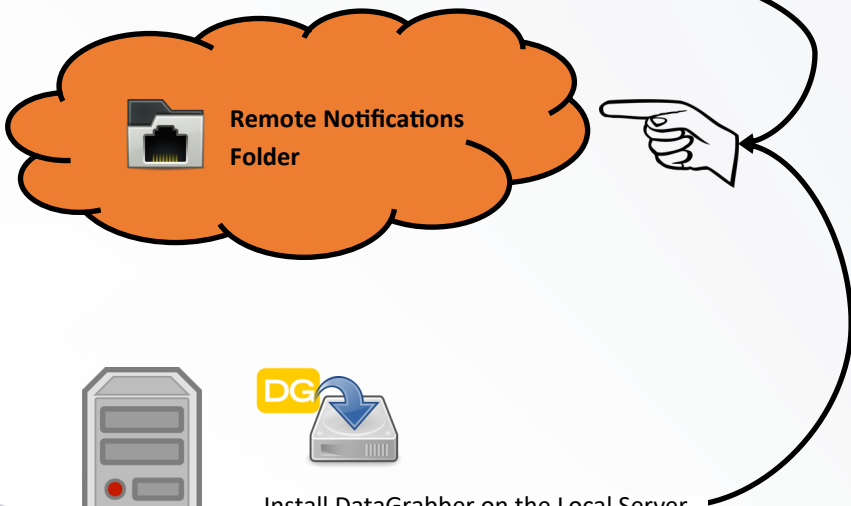
Remote Notifications



Right-clicking on the Data-Grabber logo in the Windows task tray will populate the menu for customizing settings within DataGrabber.



Install DataGrabber on the Remote Server. Enable **"Sending Remote Notifications"** in the options, and point DataGrabber to a remote folder that is accessible by both the remote session as well as the local workstations.



For managing the remote notification settings, **Options** is the menu item that you will need to select.

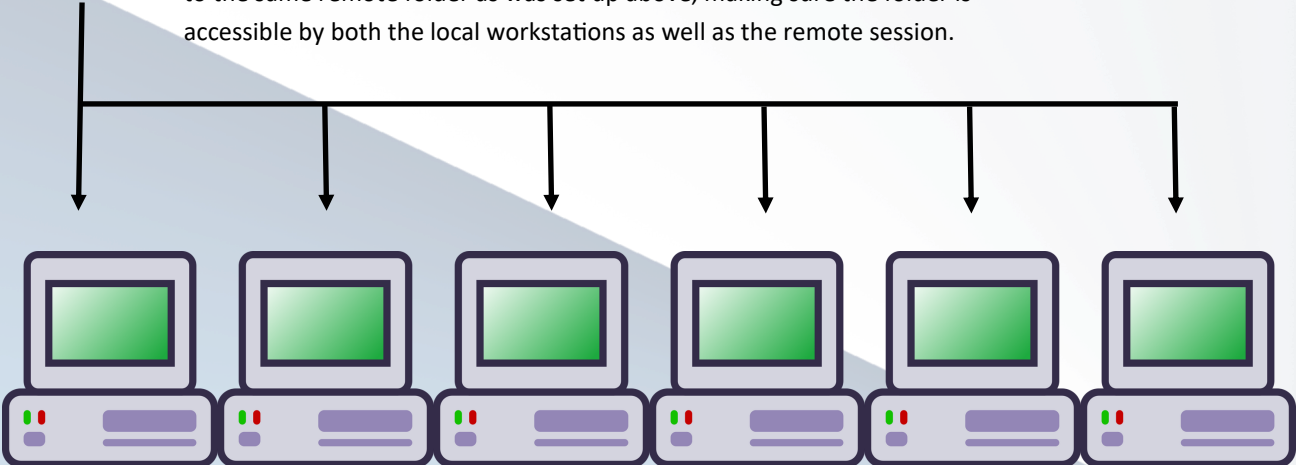
Send Remote Notifications:
 Enable the sending of remote notifications
 Remote Notification Path: _____

Receive Remote Notifications:
 Enable the receiving of remote notifications
 Perform manual file change polling
 Remote Notification Path: _____

Check and fill in the appropriate **Enable** checkbox and the **Remote Notification Path** (making sure the local PCs and remote session match or point to the exact same network location).



Install DataGrabber on the Local Server. Enable **"Receive Remote Notifications"** in the options, and point DataGrabber to the same remote folder as was set up above, making sure the folder is accessible by both the local workstations as well as the remote session.
